Funded two year old childcare

Some families whose household income is less than £16,190 may be eligible for a Flying Start for two year olds childcare place. Eligible families can have 15 hours of funded childcare a week the term after their child's second birthday.

Three and four year old childcare

15 hours for 3 and 4 year olds

All 3 and 4 year olds can access 15 hours of funded childcare a week. Simply speak to your chosen childcare provider to find out more and register with them, no eligibility check required.

Extended funded childcare for 3 and 4 year olds

Some working families may be eligible to increase their hours up to 1140 a year.

Making childcare affordable

Tax Free Childcare is one option, it is available to all working families, including those who are self-employed and have children under 12 (or under 17 if disabled). For every £8 you pay in, the government will add an extra £2, up to £2,000 per child per year - that's up to £500 every three months.
